Are you feeling down, are you having problems concerning money or are you worried about certain issues? Tilburg University wants **L** to make sure students know where to turn to with their problems.



## Lets 'plee' with Mella 🎇




What color code are we looking for? White: is in it, but not in the right place. Black: is in it and in the right place.



## **New Building**

In Tilburg's Spoorzone, next to the LocHal, there will be a new building that will house MindLabs, among others.

MindLabs is a partnership involving 4 knowledge institutions (including Tilburg University), governments and a growing community of business partners, social institutions and startups.



Together, MindLabs partners are strengthening the development of technologies that interact with human behaviour; or human-centred Artificial Intelligence. With the unique capabilities of these technologies, partners aim to help solve societal challenges.



The mission: We accelerate the development of people and society by connecting knowledge and application of interactive technology with entrepreneurship. The interaction between people and technology is central in this.



## Initiatives this University Council

During the University Council, Front submitted a letter regarding the digitalisation of education, signed by all student parties. In this letter, we express the need for an interim solution toward the implementation of blended learning. It is important to incorporate the best practices from the COVID-19 pandemic and make use of the technologies for the digitalisation of



education. Therefore, Front has submitted a letter to offer online recordings of lectures for students at least two weeks prior to exams. This way, students have reference material to better prepare for exams, but still ensure attendance.

Student Party Front submitted an initiative in this University Council on the **Extension of the Exchange Procedure**. The initiative proposes an extension of the current exchange procedure that includes motivation and extracurricular activities. Currently, selection for an exchange is based solely on GPA. We believe it is important for students to develop beyond their studies and feel that the exchange procedure should reflect the student's entire career and not just the GPA. Front has therefore proposed that the exchange procedure should be expanded to include a motivation, CV and/or scorecard.
